Tips to help support your child with their language learning



Encourage them to make flashcards then quiz them to help them practise their vocabulary and 'Keys'



Ask them to tell you what they've learnt that dayretrieving knowledge from memory strengthens the memory and leads to deeper learning

Get them to teach you something they've learnt that day in their language lesson





Encourage them to speak in French/German/Spanish at home as much as possible!



Teachers will give regular feedback on what students can do to improve- ask your child what this is and how they're going to tackle it



Encourage them to use their Sentence Builders and 'Keys' booklets to help them complete homework tasks and revise vocabulary



Encourage them to use Languagenut and Quizlet independently to develop their vocabulary & listening, speaking, reading and writing skills





Ask them to create a mind map of everything they can remember from a unit of work
